IN-PERSON COST

The NEIRA league is a registered non-profit. Suggested donation to enter the regatta grounds is **\$10 per person**. All gate proceeds are used to cover the costs of the regatta (rentals, police/fire/EMT, streaming, etc.). A cashless payment option will be available. The cashless option is \$11 to cover fees.

PARKING

Utilize the South Road Parking Garage in the UMass Memorial Medical complex. Parking along North Lake Ave is prohibited; only drop off may occur. Towing may occur along North Lake Ave.

There is no parking inside Regatta Point Park (except handicap). Cars and trailers bringing food may enter during scheduled drop-off hours and only remain in the park for 15 minutes. Your attention to and respect for this policy would be greatly appreciated.

Gate Hours:

- Tent Set-Up/Take-Down: Friday, 12:00 to 18:00, Saturday (Race Day), 6:00 to 7:00, and after the last race (approximately 5:45 p.m.).
- Spectators: Race Day only – 7:00 to 19:00

CONDUCT

No artificial noise makers or drones.

Remain clear of launching and landing docks.

Failure to follow instructions from regatta organizers and volunteers, DCR employees, safety officials, and law enforcement will result in ejection from the regatta/park. It will further impact the related crew's ability to race on Lake Quinsigamond and the NEIRA Regatta course.
